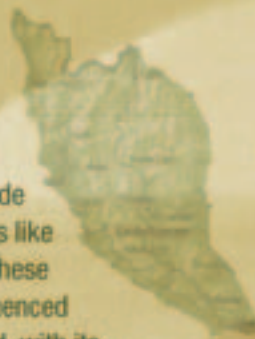


JAPAN
